**UPDATE FROM DEVELOPMENT & PEACE** The Philippines was struck by the worst disaster in its history on Friday, November 8, when super Typhoon Haijan (known locally as Yolanda) ripped through the country. DEVELOPMENT & PEACE has a long history of working in the Philippines, with a sustainable development program in the

country, and has regularly responded to natural disasters, including typhoons and most recently the earthquake in Bohol. We immediately sent a contribution of \$100,000 to our partner **Caritas Philippines-NASA** to support its diocesan staff in the distribution of food and shelter for victims of this recent catastrophe in the regions of Palo, Jaro, Capiz and Cebu.

We are collaborating with the **Cariotas Internationalis (CI)** network to support a coordinated response. A CI Emergency Response Team is currently in the city of Cebu, including a staff member of DEVELOPMENT & PEACE, to assess and coordinate relief efforts. Our short-term response will continue to focus on immediate needs, such as food, water, shelter, hygiene and essential household items. The Church has delivered eight truckloads of food packs, water, clothing and cash to the Archdiocese of Capiz, where tens of thousands of people are in need. Ten trucks have gone with food have gone to Ormoz in Leyte, nearly 50 relief packs with clothes and medicines were delivered to a local hospital in Cebu and a truck with relief supplies was sent to Bogo City in the destroyed north.
